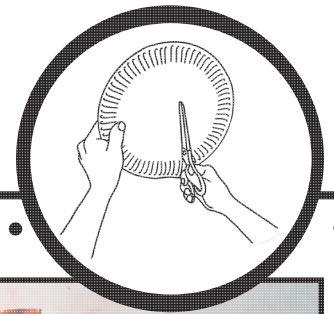
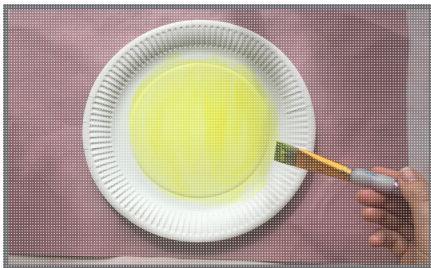
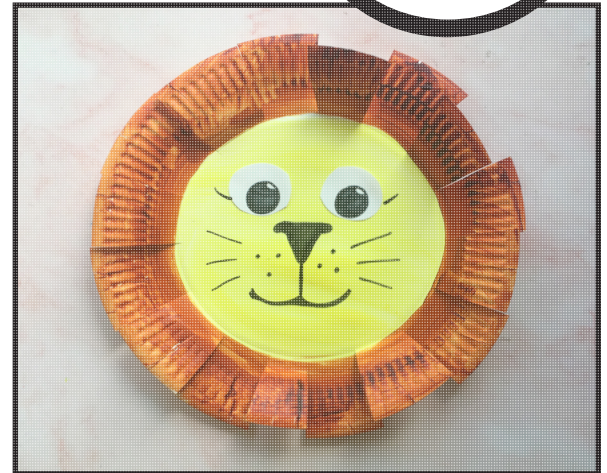


# Paper Plate Lion Craft

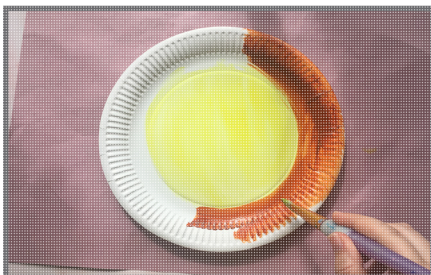


## You will need:

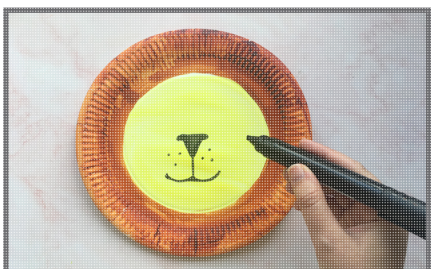
- A paper plate
- Yellow paint
- Brown or orange paint
- A black marker
- Spare white paper
- Glue
- Scissors



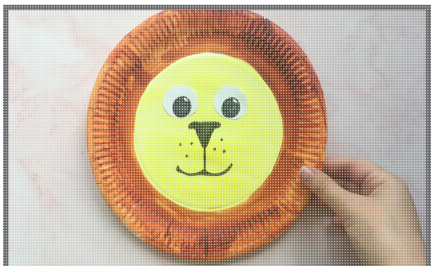
1) First, paint the centre circle of your paper plate yellow. This will become the lion's face.



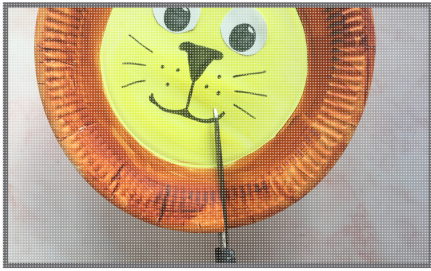
2) Now paint the outer rim of the paper plate using brown or orange paint to create the lion's mane. Leave the paint to dry.



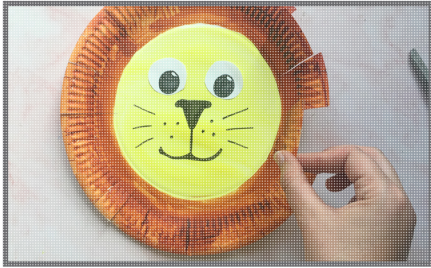
3) Once the paint has dried, use your marker pen to draw the facial features of your lion.



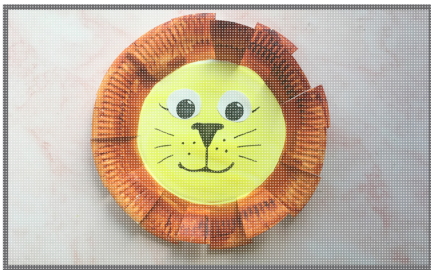
4) You can then cut some circles of white paper to create your lion's eyes. You could also choose to use googly eyes.



5) Next, use your scissors to create snips around the outer edge of the paper plate. These cuts should go from the outer edge of the plate towards the centre of the plate, stopping where the mane meets the face of the lion.



6) Now go around the edge, bending every second strip towards the centre of the plate so it no longer lies flat. This will create a 3D mane for your paper plate lion.



7) You have created a simple lion craft using a paper plate.
